What is phonics?

Phonics is the method of how to teach reading using sounds and graphemes

Synthetic phonics is simply the ability to convert a letter to a sound to create a word.

Sounds are blended together to make words.

Graphemes are the sounds written down. 150 in total ?!!!!!!!!!!



English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)


One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.






