

SNOW DAY BINGO CARD Year Reception



<u>Maths</u>

- Draw a snowman with 5 buttons. Can you draw another one with a different number of buttons? Write the numbers on the snowmen.
- Make some snowballs and count how many you can throw into a target. You can either go outside to make them or stay safe inside and use cotton wool balls, scrunched up paper or white socks.
- Make a "snowy" numberline. You could draw snowballs, snowflakes or snowmen to write your numbers on from 0-5.

<u>English</u>

- Draw a picture of yourself in your winter clothes e.g hat, boots. Can you label all of the winter items you are wearing?
- Write some cvc words in the snow e.g hat, cat, dog, man, sit.
- Use your reading book or another book you have at home to play 'I spy'. You could have a go at either drawing or writing down everything you find.

Science

Collect some snow in a pot and bring it inside. What happens to the snow? Watch it and talk to your adult about what happens.

Creative

Paint or decorate snow or ice. You could either use paints, craft materials, homemade paint (food colouring) or junk modelling materials.

Physical

Make an obstacle course. You could make a snowy one outside, or a cosy one inside. How many different obstacles and tasks can you include?
