Maths

- Measure something rectangular either in your outside space or something inside. What is the perimeter and area of it? It could be filled with snow!
- Write a Maths problem in the snow, then answer it. The trickier the better!
- Fill a measuring jug with snow. Record how much snow you have. Once it has melted, measure the amount again. Is it the same? How long did it take to melt?

<u>English</u>

- Imagine you're in the middle of a snowstorm at a place you're familiar with. Use your senses and write about what you would be experiencing. How much of our Y5 grammar can you use?
- Read two books from the 'Snow 2025' folder on MyOn.
- Write a snowy poem based in Harrogate. This could mention landmarks like Valley Gardens, Bettys, our school and could describe how the snow has changed what they look like.

Investigate whether snow sinks or floats. Why does this happen? Write up your investigation. Can you make it scientifically accurate and a fair test?
